STUDENT ABUSE AND NEGLECT

Genesee Education Consultant Services and the Genesee Intermediate School District Board are concerned with the physical and mental well-being of the students of their District and will cooperate with the identification and reporting of cases of child abuse or neglect in accordance with the law.

Each professional staff member employed by this District who has reasonable cause to suspect child abuse or neglect resulting in physical or mental injury to a student by other than accidentally means shall also notify the appropriate administrator and follow the Genesee Intermediate School District's Reporting Procedure for Student Abuse and Neglect.

The identity of the reporting person shall be confidential, subject only to disclosure by consent or court order. A reporting staff member shall not be dismissed or otherwise penalized for making a report of child abuse or neglect. Information concerning alleged child abuse or neglect is also-confidential. Any unauthorized disclosure by an official or employee of the District is a violation of the law and subjects the offender to civil liability for resulting damages.

Each building principal/program administrator should be mindful of the possibility of physical or mental abuse being inflicted on a student by a staff member. Any such instances; whether real or alleged, should be dealt with in accordance with the Genesee Intermediate School District's administrative guidelines, MCL 722.621 et seq., Board Policy #8462 established by the Superintendent.
